

How to get to the Japan Culture Center (Al. Ujazdowskie 51)

1. Reach the Three Crosses Square (Plac Trzech Krzyży), and locate the building housing the "Ermenegildo Zegna" brand. Locate an old door facing Aleje Ujazdowskie.



2. Enter the building, and locate the reception on your immediate left. Proceed past the barriers to take the lift to the 4th floor.



3. Once you reach the 4th floor, the Japan Culture Center is behind the glass door on the left.

Please also be gently reminded there is no designated parking place in the vicinity.
